

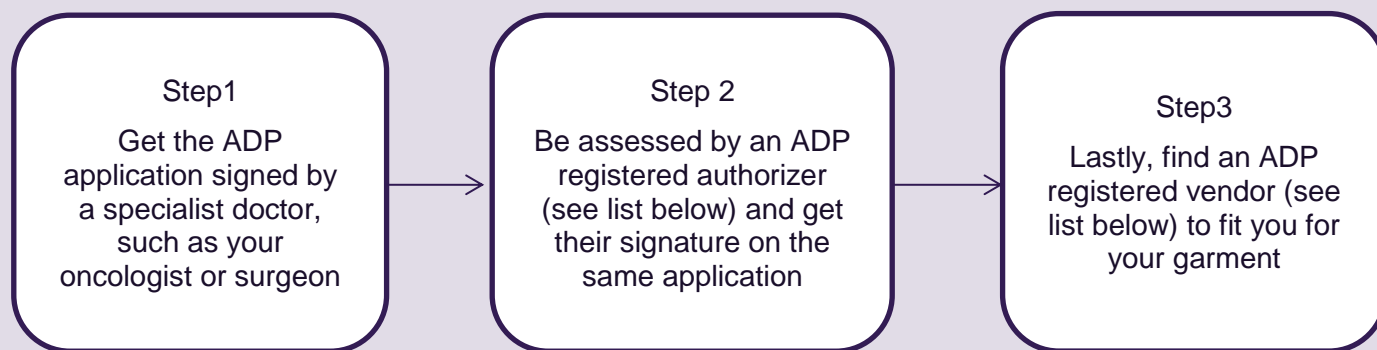
Lymphedema Management Services

Lymphedema Management Devices

Lymphedema management devices (usually called compression garments) are used to treat lymphedema by applying pressure and encouraging fluid drain in the affected area.

You can apply for help with part of the cost of your lymphedema management device through the Government of Ontario's Assistive Devices Program (ADP).

To apply through ADP, you will need to do 3 things:

Lymphedema Related Costs

- If you have extended health benefits, call your benefit provider (insurance company) to ask whether lymphedema related costs care covered by your plan and what paperwork is needed.
- Manual lymph drainage (a treatment for lymphedema done by certified therapist) is usually reimbursed under the categories of physiotherapy, occupational therapy, registered massage therapy or sometimes nursing care.
- If you have financial concerns related to lymphedema management, ask a member of your health care team for a referral to a social worker.
