Introduction

A Reacts 'Pro' subscription will allow you to perform Clinical eVisits, communicate, collaborate, and engage with your patients and colleagues in a simple and secure way.

Your Reacts Pro plan allows you to invite patients to join you on Reacts for free as "guests" (up to 1000 guests).

Please note that Reacts is a secure and confidential application which meets the high standards of the health care industry. Your personal information will always be protected.

Getting started

To perform virtual visits using Reacts, you will need:

- A computer, tablet, or a smart phone (**Secretaries:** *Your account will only be set up on a computer to ensure appropriate support can be provided*)
 - System requirements:
 - Web App: Google Chrome
 - Windows: Full version
 - iOS: iOS or higher
 - Android: Android 7 or higher
- An internet connection (cellular, Wi-Fi, or wired)
- A valid KHSC email account
- A Reacts account with a Pro subscription (set-up completed by KHSC)
- The Reacts application – either the web or mobile version

The following instructions are meant to be used as a guide to facilitate the on-boarding process for physicians, residents, and their delegated medical secretaries.

1 Have a Reacts Pro subscription assigned to you by KHSC
KHSC is completing this task for you; so no need to contact Reacts directly.

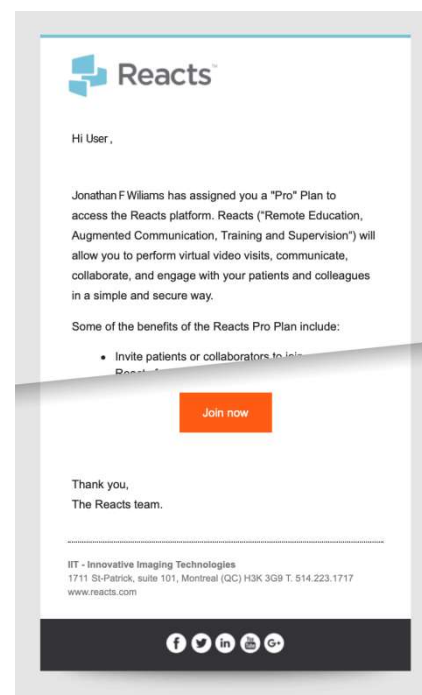
2 Complete your Reacts account registration
After KHSC assigns you a Pro subscription, you will receive an email from Reacts with information about your Reacts Pro subscription and instructions to create your Reacts account.

Click on the orange **Join now** button in the email and you will be redirected to the Reacts website to complete your account registration.

3 Completing your sign-up
Your first name, last name and email will be pre-filled based on the information provided by KSHC. You simply need to create a password and confirm it (your password must be at least 8 characters, including at least one uppercase letter, one lowercase letter, and one numeric character).

You will then need to review the Reacts / Innovative Imaging Technologies (IIT) Terms and Conditions and Privacy Policy; scroll down to the bottom of the page and check the boxes to accept them.

Finalize your account creation by clicking on the **Create my account** button.

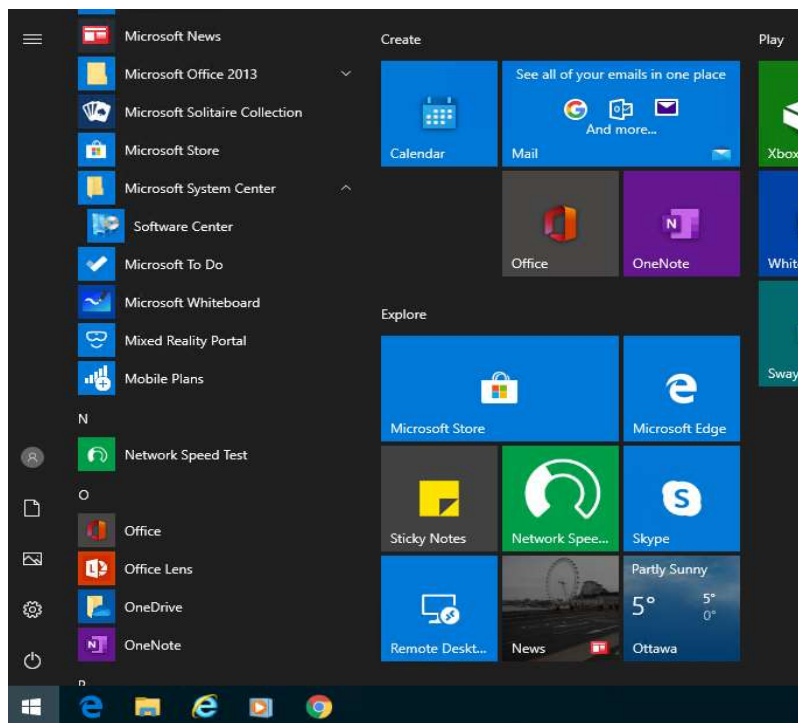

4 Download the Reacts application onto your tablet or smartphone OR access Reacts directly from your computer

Option 1 for Physicians and Secretaries: Local install on your KHSC desktop

Click Start than navigate to Microsoft System Center and Click Software Center (Windows 7 – Click Start - All Programs - Microsoft System Center – Software Center)

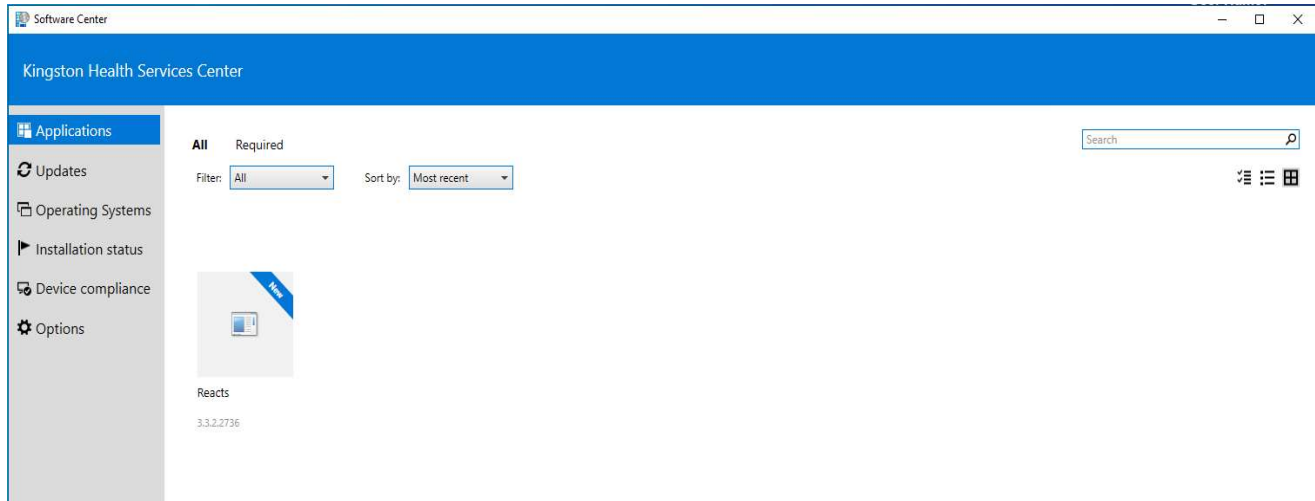

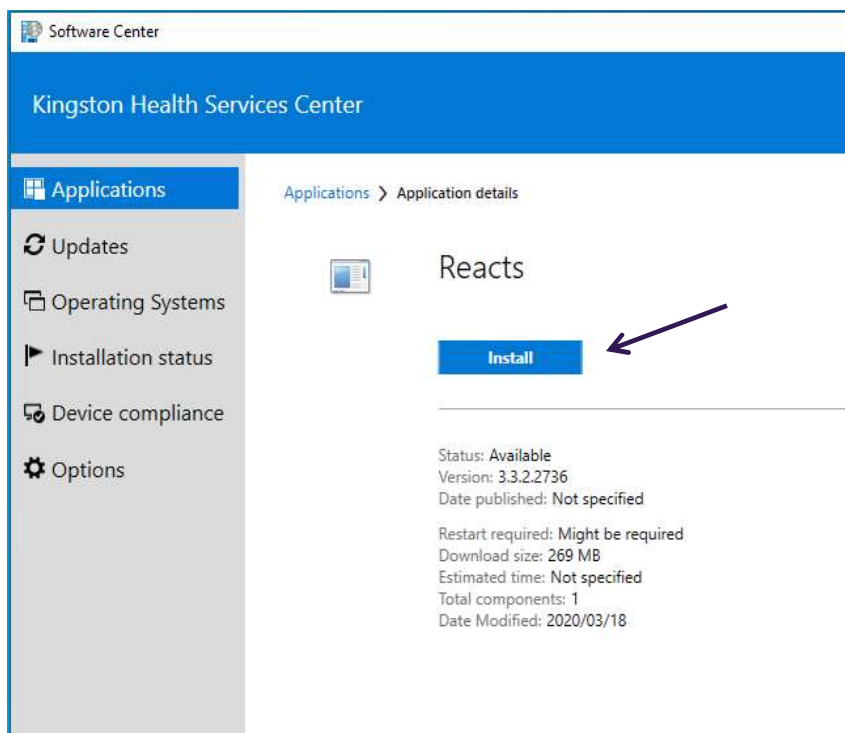

Click install

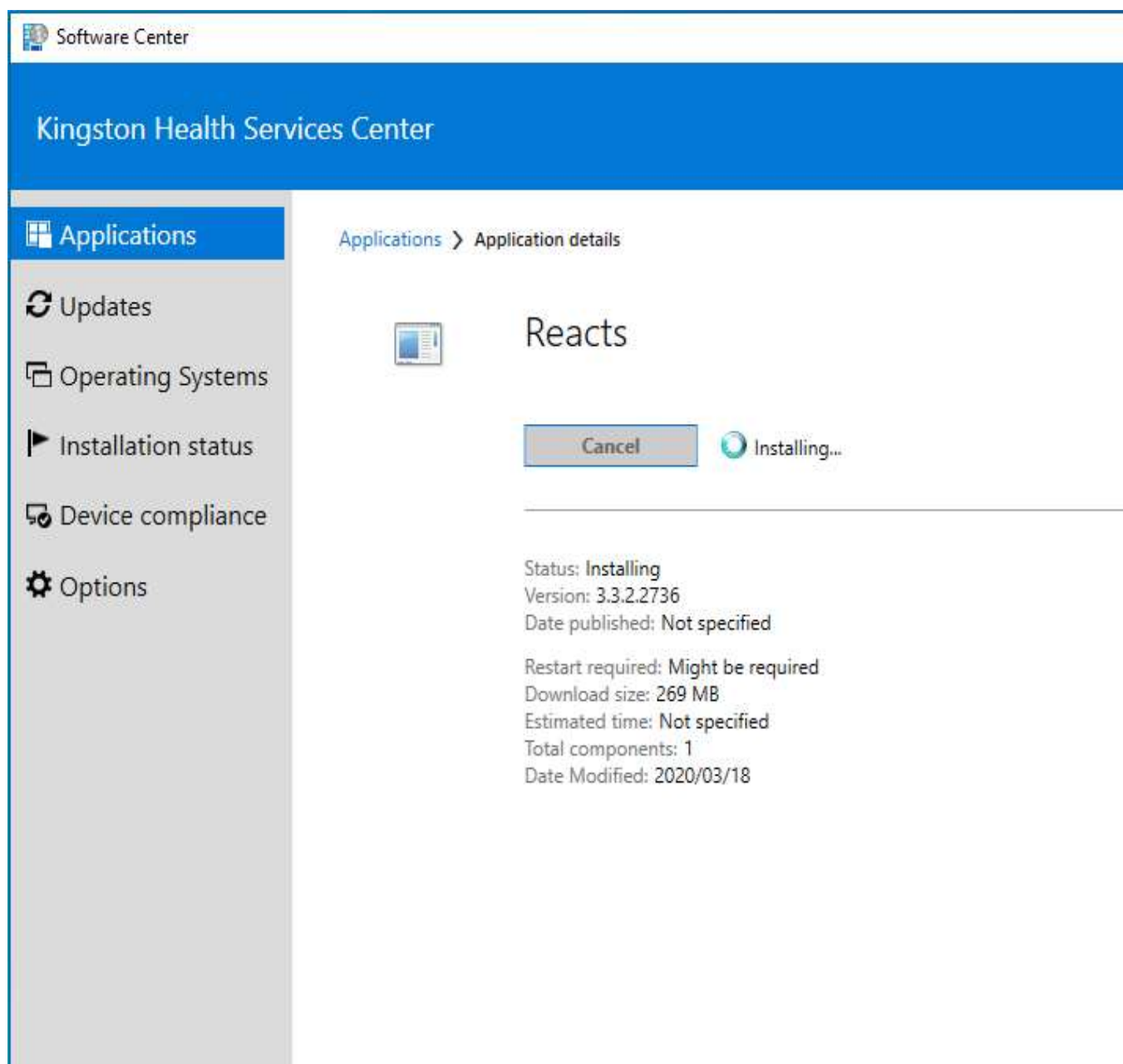

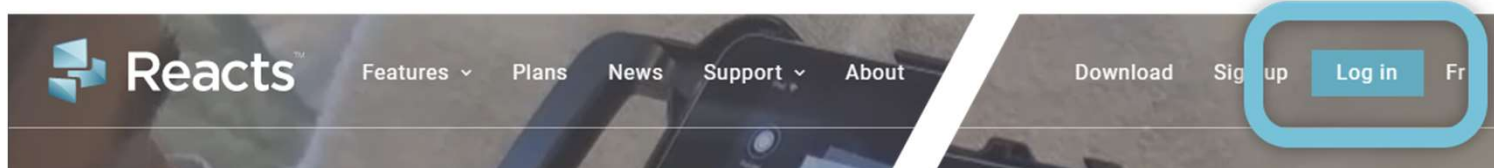

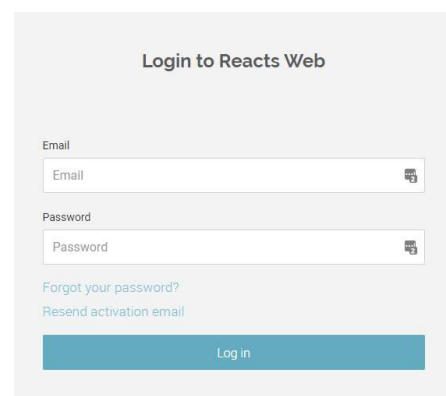
Option 2 for Physicians and Secretaries: Web-access on Google Chrome

If you are using a Mac or PC computer (laptop or desktop), you can access Reacts by using the Google Chrome browser and going to www.reacts.com (If you don't have Google Chrome on your computer, you can download it for free at www.google.com/chrome)

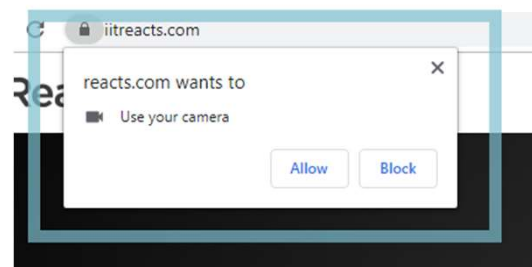
You will find the “Log In” button in the upper right corner of the screen.



It will bring you to the login page – enter your email and password and click on **Log in**.



Make sure to allow the application to send you notifications, and to use your camera and microphone



Recommended: The Reacts Web application has a screen-sharing feature when you are in a live video session with your colleagues or guests (to share pictures or documents that are on your screen). To use this feature in Chrome, install the Chrome Reacts extension by following the instructions provided.

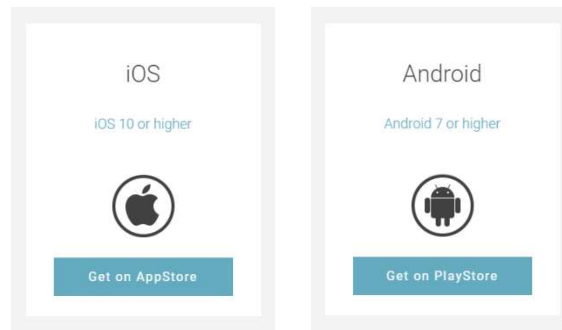

Option 3 for Physicians*: Mobile (Tablet or smartphone)

**It is recommended that secretaries only use the desktop or web-based options to ensure adequate support is available to them. This may change in the future.*

Download the Reacts application in advance from the Apple Store (Apple iPhone or iPad) or from the Google Playstore (Android phones or tablets) by clicking on the store links from the account creation confirmation email (as shown below) or type "Reacts secure collaboration" in the Apple Store or Google Playstore.

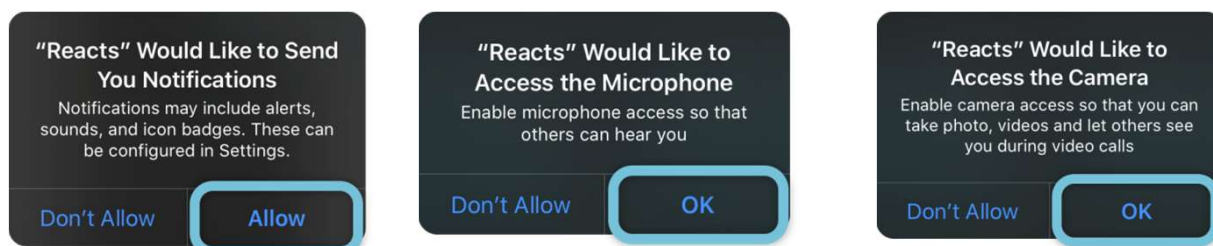


**Note: you cannot use a web browser to access Reacts on your smartphone or tablet, you must use the Reacts application downloaded from the Apple store or the Google Playstore (depending on your device type).*

Once the application has been downloaded and installed on your device, open it by clicking on the Reacts icon:



When opening the application for the first time, you will be presented with pop-ups (see below) asking you to accept Reacts sending you notifications and accessing your microphone and camera. **It is ESSENTIAL that you click Allow/OK for all three pop-ups** otherwise you will not be able to receive Reacts call and message notifications, nor see or hear your colleagues or guests during a video visit.

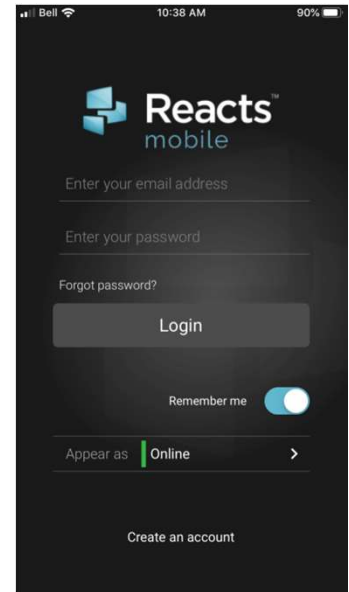


How to install Reacts on your KHSC workstation

To log in to the application, enter your email address and password. You must be logged in to Reacts in order for your colleagues or guests to connect with you. Note: set the **Remember me** toggle to “on” and you won’t have to re-enter your email address the next time you login to Reacts.

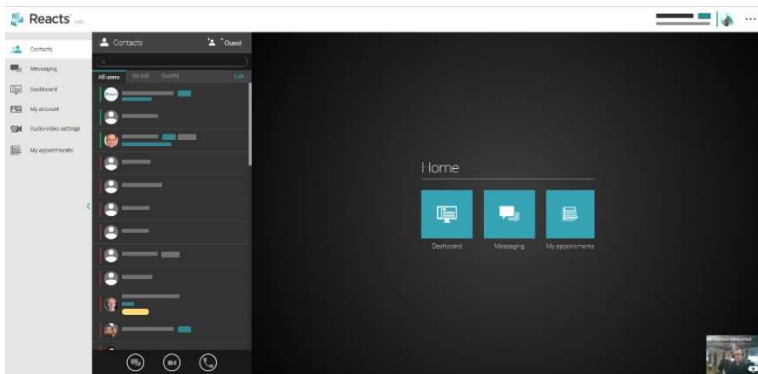


5 Log into your Reacts account *before* your video visit

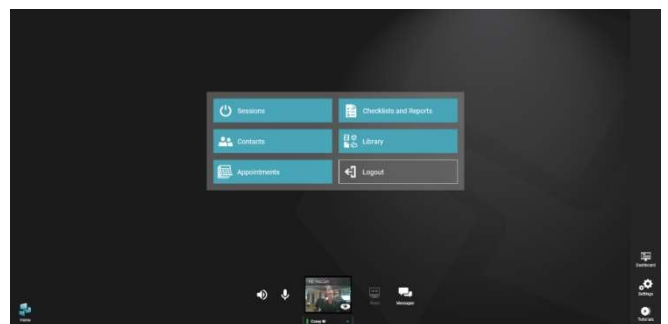
In order to use the application, please log in to Reacts with your email and the password you chose in step 3.

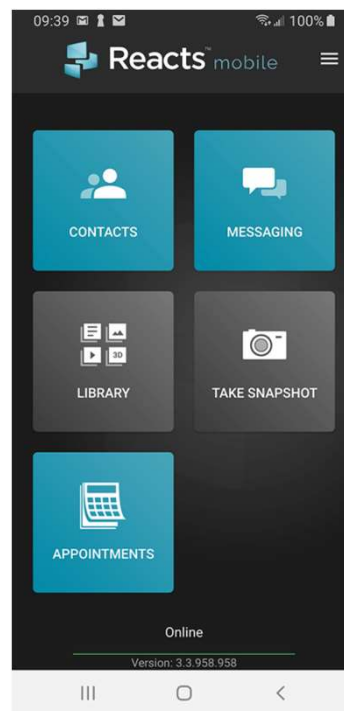

(Apple iPhone or iPad)



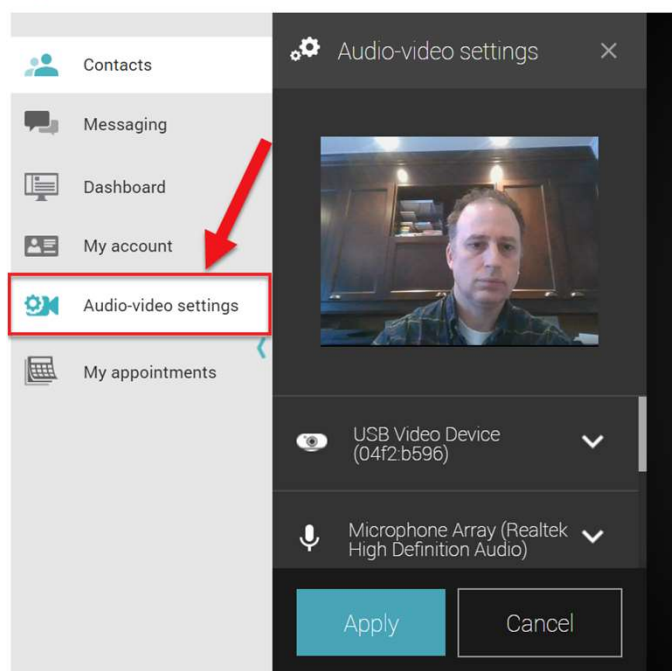
Reacts Android home page

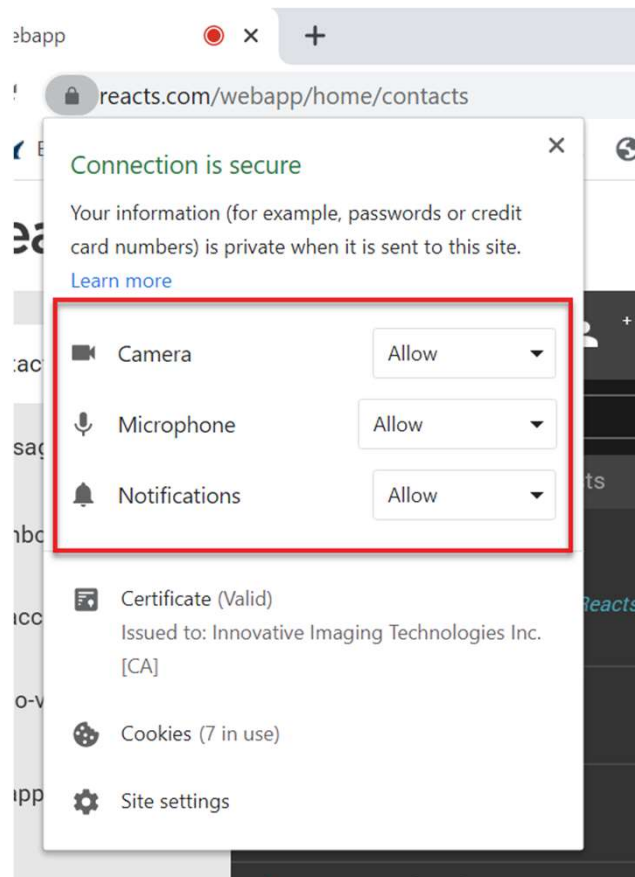
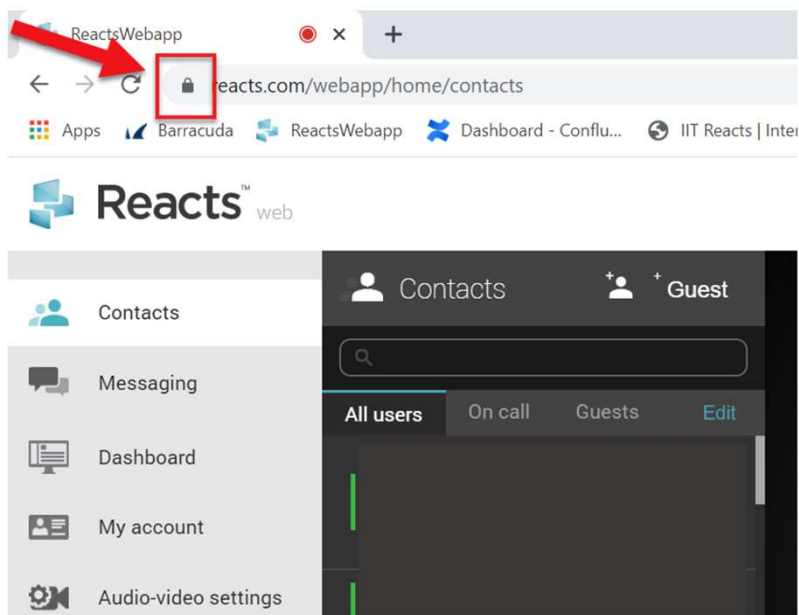
