Instructions for booking an appointment for your patient.

Please do not fax requisitions prior to being given an appointment date and time.

Please call **613-548-1385.** In the event that I am unable to take your call; please follow the protocol below and leave a message:

1. Your name and number for me to call with an appointment date and time.

Please provide your *private number* or *instructions to bypass* your phone message.

- 2. The first and last name of the practitioner that is ordering the test. Please spell the name if it is a unique name that is not easily understood.
- 3. State the type of procedure you are requesting. If it is an Anatomy scan we require a BMI (Body Mass Index) for the patient in order to select the best timeframe for a successful scan.
- 4. State patient name and date of birth. Please spell the name if it is a unique name that is not easily understood.
- 5. State the patient's health card number.
- 6. Provide the LMP or DD for the patient.

We will call you with an appointment date and time. Please write this on your requisition and **fax all paperwork to 613-548-1320.**

If you plan to have us provide additional scans for your patient: when faxing us; it is easiest for our office if you fax us the **whole package** when you have received that first appointment.

Depending on your request the following would be considered a whole package:

Requisitions for: a) Dating scan

b) NT scan- please fax us the *North York Hospital lab requisition* as well. It is not uncommon for the patient to forget to bring it with her.

c) Anatomy scan – we will book this appointment with the patient in person at her NT appointment.









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We also require copies of all previous scans done elsewhere for this pregnancy.

If for any reason your patient no longer requires her appointment; please call and let us know.

Please advise your patient to arrive 30 minutes prior to her appointment time with a full bladder—24oz (750 ml.) 1 hour prior.

General reminders:

- When booking follow-up appointments please note that we generally try to book 2 weeks after the patient's last scan.
- We require a BMI (Body mass index) for your patient. Based on this, patients' with a higher BMI will be scheduled later in her pregnancy. Some as late as 23 weeks. This allows us to obtain the best possible images for your patient.
- We will provide 2 free ultrasound pictures at no cost, to the patient during her NT scan. More extensive pictures are taken during the Anatomy scan and these are available for purchase at a cost of \$25.
