20 min.	AAA	No Prep
20 min.	Abdomen - Pelvis - Abdomen & Pelvis	 Clear fluid only for 4hrs before scan (Diabetics – 2hrs). Fluids are encouraged, patient will need to drink oral contrast Recent Creatinine/GFR if risk factors for contrast induced nephropathy exists Consent for IV contrast must accompany requisition if PT unable to give own consent.
20 min.	Chest	 Clear fluids encouraged if having IV contrast Recent Creatinine/GFR if risk factors for contrast induced Consent for IV contrast must accompany requisition if PT unable to give own consent.
45 min.	CT Cardiac Angiogram	 No solid food or drink for 4hrs before scan time (Diabetics – 2hrs). Water is allowed No caffeine either by coffee, tea or soda pop for 12hrs before scan No alcohol 12hrs before scan No smoking for 12hrs before scan time No erectile dysfunction (ED) medication for 24hrs before scan (Viagra, Cialis, etc.) Recent Creatinine/GFR within 2 months documented if risk factors for contrast induced nephropathy exist. Consent for IV contrast must accompany requisition if PT unable to give consent Beta Blockers may be prescribed to be taken before the scan to slow heart. Times will be as ordered. Nitroglycerine Beta Blockers may be used during the scan

20 min.	Enterolysis	 Clear fluids from midnight PT will have nasal or oral jejeunum tube Recent Creatinine/GFR if risk factors for contrast induced nephropathy present Consent for IV contrast must accompany requisition if PT unable to give consent Buscopan / Glucagon may be used
20 min.	Enterography	 Clear fluids from midnight Recent Creatinine/GFR if risk factors for contrast induced nephropathy present Consent for IV contrast must accompany requisition if PT unable to give consent
20 min.	Urogram	 Clear fluids only for 4hrs before scan 1000 cc water 1hr before scan Consent for IV contrast must accompany requisition if PT unable to give consent Lasix is used during scan Recent Creatinine/GFR if risk factors for contrast induced nephropathy present
20 min.	CT Angio - Cerebral Circle of Willis - Carotid - Run Off - Mesenteric - GI Bleed - Pulmonary Angio	 Clear fluids encouraged Recent Creatinine within 2 months documented Consent for IV contrast must accompany requisition if PT unable to give consent
