# **Medication guidelines before Coronary Angiogram**

#### Coumadin/Warfarin

Stop 5 days before angiogram.

# Elliquis/Apixiban

Hold 48 hours before angiogram

# Pradex/Dabigatrin

Stop 2 days before angiogram with normal renal function Otherwise check with receiving MD if creatinine in greater than 100 or GFR less than 60.

#### Xarelto/Rivaroxaban

Stop 2 days before angio with normal renal function.

Otherwise check with receiving Physican if Creatinine in greater than 100 or GFR less than 60.

# Brilinta/Ticagrelor

May continue on this medication

# Aggrenox (asprin/dipyridamole)

Skip the morning dose day of procedure and evening dose prior to procedure.

## Effient/Prasugrel

May continue on this medication

## **Aspirin**

May continue on this medication

#### **Plavix**

May continue on this medication

#### Metformin

Hold 48 hours before and 48 hours after procedure.

#### Insulin

Adjusted per referring Physician's instructions

#### Dalteparin inject.

Hold for 24 hours before procedure

# Enoxaparin inject.

Hold for 12 hours before procedure
