Test	Procedures	Instructions
Length 30 mins.	Abdomen	NPO 6hrs prior Diabetic PT may have clear fluid and non-fatty food Meds and water may be taken
30 mins.	Pelvic + / - Endovaginal	 First, empty bladder Drink 24oz of water 2hrs prior and hold If booked for pelvic U/S only, PT may eat Renal failure patients (Including those on dialysis) are not required to drink, however the urinary bladder should be as full as possible
1 hr.	Abdomen & Pelvis	 NPO 6hrs prior First, empty bladder Drink 24oz of water 2hrs prior and hold Diabetic PT may have clear fluid and non-fatty food Meds and water may be taken Renal failure patients (Including those on dialysis) are not required to drink, however the urinary bladder should be as full as possible
30 – 60 mins.	Abdominal Doppler	 NPO 6hrs prior Diabetic PT may have clear fluid and non-fatty food Meds and water may be taken
30 mins.	Renal Transplant Ultrasound	1. No Prep
30 min. Routine Scan 60 min.	OBS +/-Endovaginal	 First, empty bladder Drink 24oz of water 2hrs prior and hold PT may eat and take any necessary meds

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30 min.	TRUSP Biopsy	 Prep by Urology Patient receives pre-procedure antibiotics Heparin or Coumadin must be reversed if applicable Vital signs pre-procedure
