ROUTINE CLEANING WORKFLOW

1. Highest surfaces (least touched)
2. Mid-level, low touch surfaces
3. High touch surfaces (frequent contact)
4. Lower surfaces + floor (dirtiest in bedroom)
5. High/clean bathroom surfaces (mirror, top of dispensers, upper walls/shelves)
6. Sink and counter area
7. High touch bathroom surfaces
8. Toilet seat, rim, and base
9. Floor (most contaminated area)

NOTE: Contain slip hazards (e.g., spills) immediately, then clean at the appropriate step unless biohazardous

BIOHAZARD SPILL CLEANING

1. Put on appropriate PPE
2. Contain the spill
3. Clean first (remove visible organic matter)
4. Disinfect second
5. Dispose of waste safely
6. Perform hand hygiene
7. Change cloths
8. Resume normal cleaning workflow

Clean immediately!
