30 min.	Video Fluoroscopic Swallowing Study (Cookie Swallow)	1. NPO after midnight
30 min.	Oesophagus Stomach and Duodenum UGI	1. NPO after midnight
30 min.	Small Bowel Contrast Enema	1. NPO after midnight
30 min. up to 24 hrs.	Dedicated Small Bowel Follow Thru	1. NPO after midnight
30 min.	Contrast Enema (Large Bowel)	1. One box PICO-Salax and one packet DULCOLAX (See Prep Sheet) 2. NPO after midnight
30 min.	Cystogram Cysto Urethrogram Voiding Cysto Urethrogram (VCUG)	1. Patient to be catheterized on floor prior to exam
30 min.	Sinogram	1. No prep
50 min.	Arthrogram Joint Injection	1. No prep
1 hr.	Lumbar Puncture	1. Off Aspirin/Advil/PLAVEX 48 hours before test 2. Off HEPARIN/COUMADIN with normal blood work (as per hospital norms) 3. CBC, PT, PTT, INR 4. Signed consent 5. Lab requisitions to accompany patient for required lab tests 6. MAR nursing flow sheet 7. NPO after midnight
1-1.5 hr.	Myelogram	1. Off Aspirin/Advil/PLAVEX 48 hours before test 2. Off Heparin/COUMADIN with normal blood work (as per hospital norms) 3. CBC, PT, PTT, INR 4. Signed consent 5. Lab requisitions to accompany patient for required lab tests 6. MAR nursing flow sheet 7. NPO after midnight
